How to Enter

1. Information on how to enter, mechanics of entry, and Prize (defined below) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Entry into this promotion constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. It is important that you read and understand these Terms and Conditions.
2. The giveaway will be conducted in-person at the Promoter's event activation area at the 2025 Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500.
3. Entry is only open to the first 2,332 eligible participants who are residents of Australia, Australian citizens and permanent residents aged 18 years or over, and currently residing in Australia. Entry is limited to the earlier of 2,332 valid entries being received or the closing date/time.
4. To enter, you must:
 - (a) Visit the Subaru activation area at the 2025 Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500.
 - (b) Join the Subaru family via subaru.com.au and show the Subaru activation staff the subscription confirmation page. Subscription must be a valid opt-in to marketing communications in compliance with the Spam Act 2003 (Cth).
 - (c) After completing the subscription form and showing staff, you will be prompted to spin the Spin-and-Win wheel.
 - (d) Note: Completing the subscription form alone does not enter you into the giveaway. You must spin the Spin-and-Win wheel as well.
5. One (1) entry per person. Multiple entries are not permitted. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including proof of identity, age and residency).

Winner Selection and Prize

6. If the Spin-and-Win wheel lands on a prize, you will receive the prize displayed on the wheel.
7. The giveaway will take place at Gold Coast Hwy, Surfers Paradise, between 10am AEDT, Friday, 24th October 2025 and 5:00pm AEDT, Sunday, 26th October 2025. The Spin-and-Win wheel will be spun by the eligible participant ("**Entrant**"). The Promoter may give the Entrant the opportunity to spin the wheel again if the wheel lands on "Spin again".
8. The winner will be notified immediately if they have won a prize and the prize will be provided immediately.

19. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the States and Territories of Australia ("Non-Excludable Guarantees").
20. Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion, including without limitation:
